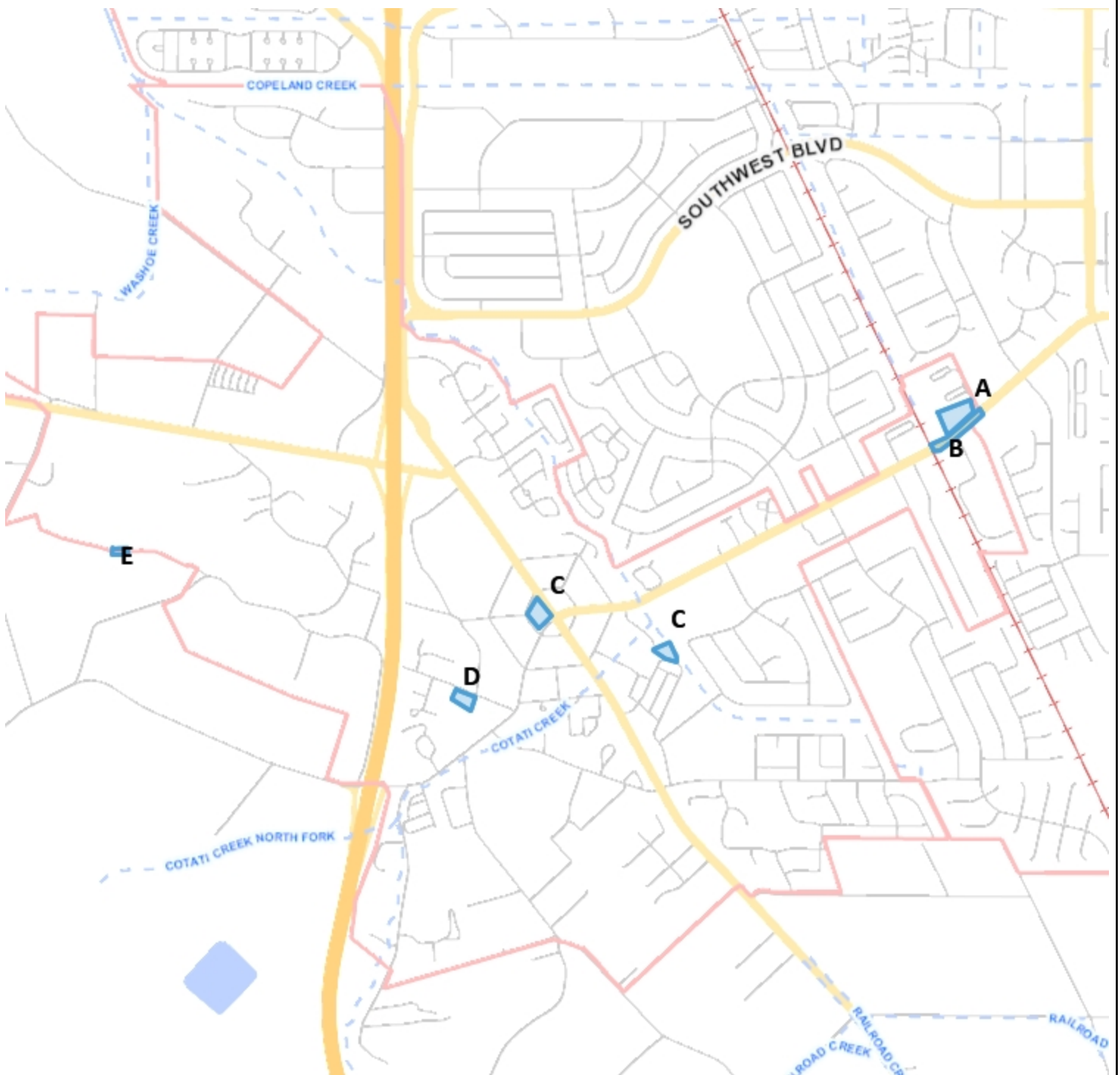

### **A. Sunflower Park Tennis Court Resurfacing Project**

Completion: Fall 2017

Description: Resurface Tennis Courts located at Sunflower Park on East Cotati Avenue.

### **B. East Cotati Street Rehab Project**

Completed: Spring 2020

Description: Repave East Cotati Avenue from the easterly side of the SMART railroad tracks easterly to the City limits, to landscape the existing median, to update traffic signs, to repair and restore to ADA compliance various cracked and lifted sections of tree root damaged sidewalk, to remove & replace trees causing sidewalk damage and install needed ADA accessibility improvements to driveways and sidewalk access ramps along this segment.

### **C. Park Lighting Project**

Design Completion: Spring 2017 (est.)

Construction: Summer 2017 (est.)

Description: Enhance lighting in La Plaza Park and in the Park Meadows Subdivision (McGinnis Circle).

### **D. Cator Field Accessibility Improvements Project**

Completed: Spring 2018

Description: Installation of approximately 493 linear feet of 5 foot wide concrete sidewalk to connect the existing sidewalk at the City's Community Center, along School Street to the westernmost side of the baseball field's parking lot and a section of sidewalk, extending along the west side of the basketball courts, connecting this sidewalk to the ballfield. The project also includes resurfacing and striping the basketball court street side parking lot.

### **E. West School Street Path of Travel Project**

Completed: Spring 2018

Description: First section of pathway which will begin from Thomas Page Elementary School on Richardson Lane and eventually connect to the School Street tunnel.

## **Projects Not Shown on Map**

1. Well 1A Improvements  
Construction to begin in July 2017 with completion in August 2017.
2. Citywide Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety Improvements. City to install three speed feedback signs in Summer of 2017.
