The Cotati City Council invites individuals who are committed to working for the betterment of the City of Cotati and who are interested in planning and implementing alternative transportation facilities, to apply for membership on the County-wide Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC). Cotati residency is required for this seat.

The CBPAC is comprised of staff and citizen representatives from all Sonoma County local agencies. The Committee advises the Sonoma County Transportation Authority (SCTA) Board of Directors on a variety of issues related to the improvement of regional alternative transportation facilities, including development of a comprehensive bicycle and pedestrian master plan, review of project funding proposals, and prioritization of alternative transportation projects. Representatives are asked to commit to a term of two years, with additional terms at the discretion of the City Council. The CBPAC meets every other month on the fourth Tuesday of the month from 1:30 – 3:30 p.m. at the offices of SCTA, 490 Mendocino Avenue in Santa Rosa.

To request an application by email or U.S. mail, contact the Deputy City Clerk at lberges@cotaticity.org or 665-3622. **Applications must be received by 5 p.m. Friday April 28, 2017.** The seat will be filled through appointment by the Mayor and ratification by the City Council at a subsequent City Council meeting.
